



Our desire at Beacon is to be able to have a weekly Sunday worship service, but also to keep our congregation safe. In order to do both, we will be following the listed guidelines. These guidelines are based on current CDC recommendations and government statements:

- 1) During May, the only building-based service will be held on Sunday morning at 11 am. All other on-line options will remain the same. The first service will be May 10.**
- 2) Everyone is asked to do pre-screenings at home. Please do not come to the church (watch online instead) if:
 - a) You have a temperature over 100.4**
 - b) You have flu-like symptoms (cough, body ache, etc.)**
 - c) If you have been exposed to someone with the above symptoms in the past 72 hours****
- 3) The chairs will be set up so that families can sit next to each other, but there will be appropriate spacing between family units.**

- 4) No food or drink of any type will be offered (no coffee, no snacks for children's church, no water fountain, no communion)**
- 5) The bathrooms can be used for emergency purposes only. They will be disinfected after each use, using a CDC recommended cleaner.**
- 6) Hand sanitizer will be made available.**
- 7) No physical contact of any type between non-household members (no handshaking, hugging, etc.)**
- 8) The offering will not be passed around. A bucket will be placed at a static location.**
- 9) Masks will not be mandatory, but feel free to wear one if you feel the need to do so.**
